In our job and task analysis process, each identified task is analyzed to determine the:

- steps,
- related knowledge,
- safety issues,
- hazardous conditions,
- unique tools/equipment
- performance standards

Through this analysis, process variances are identified and consistency in quality and operational standards are established. The task analysis information becomes the basis for creating ISO work instructions, Job Safety Analysis, and effective training materials.
